About the juror:

John Greco is a master printer and owner of Josephine Press and the Christopher John Gallery in Santa Monica, CA. He graduated with a BA from Slippery Rock University and received his MFA from Kent State University. His work is in public and private collections throughout the US and abroad. In the past, he has been an adjunct professor of art at Santa Monica College, adjunct professor of printmaking at USC, instructor of art at the American College of Applied Arts in Los Angeles and has taught at two other Universities in Ohio and Pennsylvania.

Statement from the juror:

In judging a work of art, I look for inventiveness, craftsmanship, and harmonies in composition and content. Amongst the works of art being considered for this exhibit, I found a refreshing, wide range of images, materials, and techniques employed. Some pieces that felt as if they were spontaneously created by nature and others felt meticulously labored into form. I feel privileged to have had the opportunity to focus and look deeply into the spirit of each work of art and its creator. I hope for continued success for you all.



Cyanotype Workshop - Online

Please join us for a second installment of our Online Cyanotype Workshop. Josephine Press will supply participants with Cyanotype Kits and our instructor, May Roded, will guide you through this creative and diverse process through zoom.



This workshop is offered as a 2 session course.

Dates:

Session 1: September 19th, 2020 12:00pm to 1:15pm PST Session 2: September 26th, 2020 12:00pm to 1:15pm PST

Session 1 will cover the history and process including: coating paper, collecting and preparing materials to build composition, exposure and development.

Session 2 will provide more guidance on exposure and development, as well as any Q & A for trouble-shooting and time to share with other participants.









What is Cyanotype?

Cyanotype is a simple, non-toxic photographic process that produces expressive cyan-blue print using the sun. Negatives, stencils, or objects are placed on top of a sheet of photo sensitive paper and exposed to UV light. Areas hit with direct UV light become a beautiful cyan color in the development bath, whereas areas that were blocked during exposure remain paper white. Engineers used this photographic process well into the 20th century as a simple & low-cost process to produce copies of drawings, referred to as "blueprints".


