A FEW HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE PROSPECTUS

The show is open to all USA collage artists over age 18.

Awards: First Place \$400, Second Place \$200, Third Place \$100

Entry cost: Members Forty-five dollars (\$45), Non-members Fifty-five dollars (\$55) to enter up to three pieces. Five dollars (\$5) for each additional piece. Maximum of 5 entries.

Size limits for hand-delivered pieces: Limited to hanging on an 8' wall and must fit through a 6'6" high X 36" wide door maximum weight 20 lbs.; Pedestal art—15 feet tall, weight limit 45 lbs.

For framed items, PLEXIGLAS ONLY on pieces over 16 x 24. Plexiglass is preferred for smaller framed works. Gallery wrapped canvas or wood panel does not require framing unless the edges are unfinished and must not have any visible fasteners.

FOR INFO ON REQUIREMENTS FOR SHIPPED WORK, SEE THE PROSPECTUS.








"Created over 17 years, the work is composed of 190 panels that, combined, measure approximately a quarter mile in length. An eclectic array of materials comprise the piece: textiles, mass media images, and photographs by the artist intermingle with bold passages of paint, while everyday objects such as chairs, cardboard boxes, and traffic lights add sculptural depth. Rauschenberg incorporated materials and photographs from the U.S., Asia, Europe, Latin America, and Northern Africa, including audio of ambient street sounds recorded during his travels."—LACMA (show now closed)


