PRESIDENT'S LETTER


Dear Members,

Max Presneill is an artist and a curator based in Los Angeles. An abstract painter, he has shown globally, with works that explore sub-cultural iconography, masculine identity and mortality. He is currently the Director and Head Curator of the Torrance Art Museum, with particular curatorial interests in artist-led projects, emerging art, new models for curatorial methodologies and an international scope for partnerships, exchanges and building artistic communities. CBS named him in the top 8 Best Art Curators in Los Angeles.

Sydney Cross is currently an instructor at California State University, Northridge and taught printmaking and art at Clemson University from 1981-2015 where she was awarded the title of Alumni Distinguished Professor of Art.

Some of her artworks aim "to deliver a sublime experience similar to the one we seek from media or from the consumption of goods.... As a result, the work is an attempt to define a critique of our relationship to nature as a commodity. Nature as an entity that must perform, decorate, amuse, and ultimately conform to a profit based economy."
