Influenced by the works of Romare Bearden, La Monte Eugene Westmoreland has been an active artist for the past forty years. His personal and humanistic work is included in over 160 prestigious art collections worldwide. His images have also appeared in over 50 books and catalogues, as well as numerous articles and reviews in art magazines, periodicals and newspapers. La Monte's work is focused on his political and humorous perceptions of his African American life experience. He uses Pop Icons such as watermelons, Uncle Ben, and Aunt Jemima that represent black imagery and illustrate racial stereotypes from both the past and present.




