We have a *very* exciting year ahead of us! We at CAA have many new things happening that will only better our organization and offer our members so much more than we ever anticipated. Keep reading!

With the downturn in our economy we found ourselves not only losing members—but our rental at the JCC was increased by 75%! Not only has it been really hard to get people to volunteer or serve on the board, but we found ourselves in a very doom-and-gloom situation. However, I have always been of the opinion that when things get that bad, something always happens for the best. Well, it has!

We have been fortunate to acquire a new location to hold our meetings; many of you who are members of VAG and VWS will be familiar with this venue. It is the Encino Community Center (4935 Balboa Blvd. at Ventura), and we are going to have our *first meeting there in November*. There will be a few changes, however, but many, most likely all, will be to your advantage.

First of all, we will be holding meetings on *the first Wednesday morning of the month starting in November* and will also offer (for no increase in membership fee) *nine meetings per year*. ### **BYLAW REVISION:**

The following change *must* be voted on by the membership at the September meeting. Please be sure to attend—*your* vote counts:

#### **Article V—Meetings**

##### **Section 1                      Membership Meetings**

**Regular meetings of the membership shall be held a minimum of five (5) and up to nine (9) times a year to be determined by the Board of Directors. Membership meetings are open to the public.**

### **EXHIBIT REPORT**

Our next Exhibit, “Reconstruction,” is open to all members of CAA plus members of these invited organizations: Women Painters West, Valley Artist Guild, Valley Watercolor Society and Artist Co-op 7. You must be able to hand-deliver your work to VIVA. Because we are expecting many entries, size limits are a maximum of 16” X 20” for 2-D work and 12” X 12” for 3-D work. All entered pieces must have collage incorporated in a meaningful way.

**Take-in: Monday, October 12, 2009 10:00 a.m. – noon**

**Pickup of non-accepted work: Monday, October 12, 2:30-4 p.m.**

**Show runs Wednesday, October 16– Saturday, October 31, 2009**

**Reception: Sunday, October 18, 2009 2–4 p.m.**

**Takedown: Saturday, October 31, 2009 4-5 p.m.**

If you are juried into the show, you will have to sit the gallery, so bring your calendar in the afternoon of Oct. 12..

In judging a work of art he looks for inventiveness, craftsmanship, and harmonies in composition and design.
