CAA GUEST ARTIST March 28, 2014 JON MEASURES

Jon Measures is a British mixed-media artist based in Los Angeles. After receiving a degree in Fine Art from Falmouth School of Art in 1987, Jon spent time in Manchester and London before settling in Los Angeles in the late 1980s. He has consistently produced art while enjoying a successful career as a graphic designer, illustrator and educator. Over the past three years, Jon made the transition from a working designer to a full-time exhibiting artist.

Jon's artwork portrays his interest in representing not only the physical environment but also a view of the emotional nature of places and our connections to them. His mixed-media paintings incorporate digitally edited photographs, drawings and paintings that are first printed out and collaged on wood panels then further worked using acrylic, glaze and spray paint to add texture and color. He describes his process as a hybrid of painting, drawing, photography, digital art and collage, combined to echo the layering of structures and history that takes place in our built environment. The work is both a critique and a celebration of our constructed spaces.
