Rachelle Mark has been a practicing artist in the Los Angeles area for the past 25 years. Her diverse body of work includes painting, collage, monoprint and encaustic, as well as free-standing and sculptural functional art. Rachelle's artwork is inspired by her world travels and personal vocabulary of images. She has had solo shows in galleries across Los Angeles, and has participated in numerous group shows both in California and internationally.
