

#### "PAINTING WITH LIGHT ON FABRIC"

**Christel Thompson, Instructor**

In this hands-on workshop, participants will be instructed in the use of non-toxic light-sensitive products to create intriguing two- and three-dimensional artworks on silk and cotton/muslin. Christel will also introduce examples of various substrates and methods for creating your vision or design. Exploration and experimentation are encouraged!

Christel Thompson is a Los Angeles multi-media artist hailing from the Midwest, where she had her first artistic experience as a child throwing mud pies on the back of a white farm house. From that moment, her experimental nature in art began to flourish. Christel's media of choice is "anything she can experiment with" and ranges from mixed-media to sculpture, assemblage and alternative photographic processes. She is inspired by dreams, curiosities, birth, growth, decay, nature and music.

Christel is a two-time Emmy winner for Outstanding Graphic Design. She is an active member of CAA (currently serving on the board as Philanthropy Chair), and Los Angeles Experimental Artists Group II. Her work has been exhibited in a number of galleries in Illinois and California, and she's received numerous awards in juried shows.

#### **CAA SCHOLARSHIP WINNER**

Victor Braseau is a sculptor, designer and mixed-media art student at California State University, Northridge. Victor was selected to receive CAA's 2015 Scholarship Award because his passion for the process is clearly evident in the way he combines sculpture with salvaged materials and collage to create works of art that are both soulful and dynamic. He is currently working on a proposal for Los Angeles County Museum of Art's 2016 Art & Technology Lab that expands on that process to create an interactive hybrid of sculpture and user interface, composed of remnants of passed ones' lives super-imposed with images uploaded by their loved ones. Victor will use his scholarship award to help fund a prototype supporting his proposal.
