Please join us at the June 30 meeting to welcome and install our new officers and enjoy our special meeting with presentations from our fellow members.







The London-based group describes themselves as "independent artists weaving grit-pop, alt-torch, blues rock and psychedelia into interactive video-collages." Sound collage is nothing new. Pop musicians using collage as visuals for the albums isn't either. But The Nyco Project takes things to a whole new level by experimenting with their recording process and integrating sound and visual components.




