<u>A collection of material</u> related to a specific person, event, or memory that you want to deconstruct and transform. This could include:

- Letters
- Postcards
- Photographs
- Paper ephemera
- Books, magazines
- Previously created artwork
- Paper or fabric from the associated era
- Colors, textures, symbols, and images that remind you of the subject

Deconstructing tools:

- Scissors
- Optional: Exact-o blade, hole-punch
- Any other deconstructing tools you use or would like to experiment with

Binding materials:

- Liquid glue in a cup
- Glue brush
- Optional: tape, staples/stapler, needle/thread, pins, string
