## **Painting with Collage Shapes (and paint too!)**

*Make Art Collages with only paint, paper and glue. 2 Hour Workshop  
I will make small assemblages using a mixed bag of paint, papers, and gel medium as my glue. You can either paint along or simply watch.  
It's a fun way to make art when taking a break from painting!*

*You can expect a lively, instructional, 2 hour social gathering, where you can finish art pieces in under two hours!*

### **Suggested Materials:**

1. Paints: Any professional-grade watercolor or acrylic paint, fluids or acrylic inks. Primaries + Black and White
2. Prepare the surfaces: Up to 4 sheets, 300 lb. watercolor paper CP, 11x14 or similar (Bob recommends Cheap Joe's Kilimanjaro Watercolor Paper) - Pre-Gesso all paper, 1 side only. Must be dry for the beginning of workshop.
3. Assortment of any type of collage paper for gluing. Have a few sheets of black (any dark color is fine) tissue paper handy, as well as other colors and/or patterns.
4. Regular Acrylic Gel Medium, any brand - used for gluing. OR - any kind of water-soluble glue, like Elmer's.
5. Several 1" Flat or 1-1/2" filbert for painting AND 1" flat brush for gluing
6. Squeegee or disposable strips of cardboard or form board
7. Paper tape to hold your paper.
8. Water container, such as a low Tupperware-type container. (They don't fall over)
9. Roll of VIVA towels or similar.
10. Bob works on flat tables that are covered with a clear 4ml plastic sheets.
