Painting with Collage Shapes (and paint too!)

Make Art Collages with only paint, paper and glue. 2 Hour Workshop
I will make small assemblages using a mixed bag of paint, papers, and gel medium as my glue. You can either paint along or simply watch. It's a fun way to make art when taking a break from painting!

You can expect a lively, instructional, 2 hour social gathering, where you can finish art pieces in under two hours!

Suggested Materials:

1. Paints: Any professional-grade acrylic paint. Primaries + Black and White. Bob will use Holbein Artist Acrylic paint.

2. Assortment of any type of paper for gluing. Have a few sheets of black (any dark color is fine) tissue paper handy, as well as other colors and/or patterns.

3. Regular Acrylic Gel Medium, any brand - used for gluing. OR - any kind of water-soluble glue, like Elmer's.

4. 1" flat brush for gluing

5. Squeegee or disposable strips of cardboard or form board

6. Prepare the surfaces: I recommend Cheap Joe's Kilimanjaro Watercolor Paper, 300 lb. CP, 11x14 - Gesso all paper, 1 side only. Let dry. You will need 4-6 pieces of watercolor paper - size is up to you. Bob will work on 10x10 inch surfaces.

7. Paper tape to hold your paper.

8. Water container, such as a low 10x10 inch Tupperware-type container. (They don't fall over)

9. Roll of VIVA towels or similar.

10. Bob works on flat tables that are covered with a clear 4ml plastic sheets.
